- You will not be paid for your services as a Speaker, nor will your expenses be reimbursed, unless you have a separate written agreement with Samsung Electronics Co., Ltd., acting through its Foundry Business ("Samsung"), regarding the Event.
- 2. Upon Samsung's request, you agree to provide a copy of your presentation and other related materials to Samsung ("Presentation Materials") in advance of the Event for Samsung's review. You understand that in the event that any materials used in your presentation contain the work of other individuals or organizations, including, but not limited to, copyrighted music, images, or other materials, it is your responsibility to secure any necessary permissions and/or licenses to use in connection with this Event from the owner of such work. You certify that you have secured the necessary permissions from the third-party owner to use any such third-party materials or have not used any third-party materials in your presentation.
- 4. You agree and give permission to Samsung to take photos and make video recording of your performance at the Event, including your Presentation Materials. You hereby grant Samsung a nonexclusive, royalty-free, perpetual, irrevocable, worldwide license to publish, reproduce or otherwise use your

- 10. This Agreement is governed by the laws of the State of California, USA, and may not be modified except by a writing signed by both parties.
